

## **The Pavilion Cheltenham – Advice on getting there by public transport**

The Pavilion can be found in Hatherley Lane, Cheltenham, GL51 6PN.

The easiest way to get there is by car, as it is near to Junction 11 of the M5. However, for those who would consider coming by public transport here are some ideas.

### By bus or coach

The Arle Court transport hub (100, Hatherley Lane) is about a 10-minute walk from the Pavilion. I haven't put the postcode, as when I put it into google maps it does not pick quite the right place. Here is a link to the website:

You can get buses into the centre of Cheltenham and Gloucester and it also advertises Flixbus and National Express. It also says there are taxis there.

(The Pavilion website shows bus routes within Cheltenham but then you have to figure out where to get off and how to walk from the bus stop.)

### By train

Cheltenham train station is about a 30-minute walk from the Pavilion.  
Note that Cheltenham train station is not in the centre of Cheltenham, so you can't get a bus direct to Arle Court from there. If you don't want to walk (or get a taxi) then Gloucester train station might work better for a bus connection.
